Edward Bruce Taylor (known as Bruce) was born in Molong on 5 Jul 1924. He was a son of Edward and Sarah Taylor and he had an older sister, Ivy. Edward had served in the AIF in WW1 on the Western Front with the 54th and 55th Battalions.

Ivy and Bruce attended the Cumnock Public School and participated in school concerts throughout their schooling years.

Bruce was working in Sydney when he enlisted in the Australian Army on the 23 Jul 1942, aged 18 years. He stayed in NSW and was discharged from the Army on 28 Jul 1945.

Bruce married June Heins in 1952 at Newtown, and they had two daughters.

Bruce, aged 74 years, died at Sydney on 1 Jan 1999. He was cremated and his ashes installed at his grandmother's, Sarah Ann Taylor, grave at the Cumnock Cemetery.
